1. The Soil written by Prabhat Sapkota and illustrated by Yuwak Shrestha

Story from Nepal

2. King of Trees written by Martin Lebotse and illustrated by Moses Dhladhla Story from South Africa

King Tree navigates various adversities of nature in the forest. How will King Tree continue to survive and provide food for other creatures in the forest?

3. Garden of Medicines written by Kedar Shrestha and illustrated by Narayan Prasad Bohaju Story from Nepal

Learn all about gardens and the benefits of fresh herbs and vegetables.

Story from Bangladesh
