Stories are what bind us together — as a human race, as a community, as a Room to Read Family and as a chapter team. Studies have found that people are more moved by a story, rather than numbers (Time article, Harvard Business Journal). You can have all the charts, graphs and numbers in the world to back up a cause, but if you don't have a story about a real person to explain how your work makes a difference on individual lives, then people aren't going to feel connected to your work. Getting people to FEEL is the key and the way to do that is to tug at their heart strings.

Providing testimonials and visual aids (photos or videos) of a child impacted by our work allows people to feel connected to the work — and just as important is YOUR story on why you volunteer for Room to Read.

Chapter members, donors and community members will not only want to hear your story and reasoning for following Room to Read, but they'll also use your story as a springboard or mirror to reflect on their own motivation for joining the Room to Read chapter network.

It's important that you own your story — and share it with the world!
